

Actively ENGAGE Learning (and actually ENJOY learning!)

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1. Take ownership of learning.

“I can’t **teach** you how to... but I can help **you learn**.”

The focus shifts from teacher to student.

“But be doers of the word...” James 1.22-24

2. Teachers: actively engage your learners.

a. Controller: Formulaic, one size fits all

b. Facilitator: relational, responsive.

*“There’s a big difference between **knowing about** something and truly **understanding** it. Turning mere facts into personal meaning is the **central** element in learning. All too often we attempt to memorize information so it can be regurgitated to pass a test without any real attempt to understand what it really means.”*

3. Students: become actively engaged learners.

a. Passive, Spectator student: bored and disengaged

b. Actively engaged student: curious and enthusiastic
