Example 2

A=4.0, B=3.0, C=2.0, D=1.0, F=0

Example 3

93-100% = A, 85-92% = B, 75-84% = C, 70-74% = D, Below 70% = F

Example 4

90-100% = A, 80-89% = B, 70-79% = C, 60-69% = D, Below 60% = F
