Scriptural assurance that you CAN homeschool through high school

- Reason for Confidence: God’s Lovingkindness. Psalm 36:7
“How precious is thy lovingkindness, O God! And the children of men take refuge under the shadow of thy wings.”
- Your Child is Given to You: Psalm 139:13-16
You child was made for your family, you can’t thwart his plan, He knows what He is doing
- You are Capable: Philippians 4:13
“I can do all things through Him who strengthens me.” It does NOT say “except this”
- One Step at a Time: John 2:1-11. Jesus turned water into wine, commanding steps, not results
- Love Covers Any Missteps: 1 Peter 4:8
“Above all, love each other deeply, because love covers over a multitude of sins.”

Scriptural encouragement for every situation

- Reluctant Parents: Exodus 4:10-13. Moses said “Please don’t make me!”
- The Great Pause: Proverbs 22:6. Pause between training up, and when they are old
- The Parenting Cycle: Romans 3:23; Proverbs 22:6; Proverbs 31:28. Sad, promise, blessed.
- Children Don’t Listen: Luke 18:31-34. Neither did the disciples, and Jesus understands.
- Surviving Storms: Acts 27:25. God’s promises are true even in storms or disasters.
- Negative Feedback: Romans 3:23; Jeremiah 31:3; Psalm 46:10. All have sinned.
- Morning Meeting: Psalm 143:8. Have a morning meeting with God (quiet time) and children.
- The Present Evil Age: Galatians 1:3-4. Every age feels like the present evil age.
- Anxiety: Philippians 4:6a. Wrong interpretation: be anxious. Correct interpretation; pray.
- Lather, Rinse, Repeat: Matthew 11:28-30. We get upset, we rinse our sin, we get back to it.
- Easy as Walking on Water: John 6:16-21. Face the storms without fear. God is with us.
- Everyone Stumbles: Isaiah 40: 29-31. Weariness solution: quiet time with God.
- Financial Contentment: Hebrews 13:5-6. Be thankful for your homeschool freedom
- Children Grow Up: 1 Corinthians 13:11, Mark 16:15. Our children change and grow.
- Road Signs: Psalm 32:8. Simple solution: tried and true curriculum. Big picture: quiet time.
- Not Ashamed: Psalm 25: 1-2; 31:1; 71:1; 119:31; Isaiah 50:7. Unashamed because of God.
- Lessons from Noah: Genesis 6:8. Noah received persecution for 100 years. We are not alone.
- Driving You Crazy: Ephesians 2:10. Our calling is not their calling.
- Delight Directed Learning: Romans 12: 6-8. Your child’s gift may be annoying
- No Perfect Schools: Romans 12:3. No school or homeschool is perfect. No, not one. But we are right where we are supposed to be.
