- 1. Establish a Mission-Vision – This is who we are!**
Deuteronomy 6:9 “Write them on the doorposts of your house....”
Maps, Globes, Newsletters on the fridge, International Decorations
Coffee table Bibles, Atlas, Missionary books
- 2. Passports – Just for fun, Just in Case!**
Make Mission Passports (craft) – for fun, learning, and prayer! -- harvestministry.org/passports
Get real Passports for everyone in your family, just to be ready
- 3. Learn about the World**
Books, Biographies, online teaching (40-day challenge videos) -- harvestministry.org/challenge
Enjoy international culture: food, music, fashion, design, and people
- 4. Pray for the World and for the Lost**
Resources: *Operation World*, *Window on the World*, world news, mission newsletters
Learn the names of every nation: lizardpoint.com – Learn about unreached people: JoshuaProject.net
- 5. Give Generously to Missions – and be Creative!**

Go “window shopping” for mission needs – *Get a Vision for what your \$\$ can do for God’s Kingdom!*
Be creative – (See ShopYellowwood.org – MissElainious.com – *pillowcase dresses, bunnies, fleece blankets*)
- 6. Use Your Home for Mission-Minded Hospitality – and as an Embassy for Local and Global Missions**
Welcome missionaries, ministers, international guests, and neighbors
- 7. Honor Missionary Heroes**
Esteem missionaries (real life and in books)
- 8. Be Ambassadors for Missions in your Church – in your sphere of influence – and Online**
Help and inspire others who are in a “going” season
Help with projects, like Operation Christmas Child
Organize mission projects, Speak and blog about missions, Encourage homeschoolers for missions
- 9. Reach out in your Local Community – Love God and Love People**
Official projects and outreaches: nursing homes, door-to-door, acts of kindness and Gospel evangelism
On the lookout: in stores, at the gas station, when you see people you know. *Love Does*, by Bob Goff
- 10. Go**
Seek the Lord about how your family could participate in a short term mission.
Expand your “box” of what this looks like (maybe dad and/or mom, maybe one parent and an older child, maybe the whole family together, maybe one older teenager).
